DIRECT TO TENANT RENTAL SUBSIDY (DTT)

Funding for new applicants of the Direct to Tenant Rental subsidy (DTT) has ended for the fiscal year. If you are currently receiving this benefit, watch for an Annual Review Form in your mail. We are happy to help you in renewing this benefit.

LOW INCOME PROPERTY TAX ALLOWANCE

If you and your spouse have a combined taxable income of less than \$22,000, you are eligible for up to \$300 rebate; income between \$22,001 and \$25,000, you are eligible for up to \$200 rebate; and income between \$25,001 and \$30,000, you are eligible for up to \$100 rebate. Feel free to reach out to us at the Charlotte County Resource Centre for application assistance.
